## Reports/Old business:

  - Markings are custom self-made decals using an inkjet printer.
  - A custom pilot sits in the cockpit
  - It has Robart retractable main landing gear with gear doors (that were not attached as displayed at the meeting), and a fixed tail wheel has been relocated to the correct scale position.
  - Power is a G-Mark .061 R/C with functional throttle control, and a Cox prop. Doug is planning on changing the prop to an APC 5.7 X 3 to try and get better performance out of it.
  - The receiver is a full size receiver that will be changed to a lighter unit.
