**El Dorado Airport** – Loren Tregallas reports that he has been working with El Dorado to have the following events:

Will need to work on different logistics for layout. Since this is the 50<sup>th</sup> WRCC auction, Fred has been contacting regional AMA officials to attend. Will have a meeting this coming week to start the planning process.
